<u>Role</u> :	HOME LIBRARY SERVICE
<u>Place</u> :	The Local Library
<u>Reports to</u> :	Local Library staff
<u>Purpose</u> :	To deliver a Home Library Service to people who are unable to visit the library themselves
<u>Responsibilities</u> :	 Visit the library to select stock for an individual or group of people who are housebound Deliver the items to the customer in their own or residential home Liaise with staff on the requirements of the customer Visit regularly, usually fortnightly
<u>Requirements</u> :	 An ability to get on with people, particularly older people Be reliable to ensure a regular service A background of reading and an interest in books If you use a car for deliveries a number of simple vehicle document checks will be required A Disclosure and Barring Service check (formerly CRB check), paid for by the library service
<u>Commitment</u> :	 Approximately 2 – 3 hours per month; visits can be fortnightly or monthly and are arranged to suit the volunteer as well as the customer, but should be regular
Length of Opportunity:	On-going
<u>Expenses</u> :	Travel expenses are paid; at the present time 45p per mile is paid for the use of own car
<u>Training</u> :	Training will be given on library services, stock selection procedures and Health & Safety guidelines; a personal introduction will be given to customers, further training may be offered from time to time
