

Risk assessment of work experience placements or employees under the age of 18

Please note:

• To be completed by the host manager before the placement commences.

It is a statutory requirement that WEP or employees under 18 are not given duties that:

- Are beyond any physical or psychological limitations which they might have;
- Expose them to any substance which is toxic or is classified as a carcinogen;
- Expose them to ionising radiation;
- Expose them to extreme heat, noise or vibration.

In addition, all other risks must be assessed and adequately controlled.

The significant risks the WEP/young person may face during the course of their placement have been assessed as:
