## **Adoption Statement May 2013**

## Notice of adoption of the Wiltshire and Swindon Aggregate Minerals Site Allocations Local Plan

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Regulations 26 and 35 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012, that the Wiltshire and Swindon Aggregate Minerals Site Allocations Local Plan ("the Plan") was formally adopted by Swindon Borough Council and Wiltshire Council at their respective Council meetings on 11 April 2013 and 14 May 2013.

The Plan presents a positive and flexible framework of seven sites for future mineral extraction for the period up to 2026. Now adopted, the Plan forms part of the development plan for Wiltshire and Swindon.

The Plan was the subject of an independent examination conducted by an Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State. The Inspector's Report was published in February 2013 and the recommended main modifications have been included in the adopted Plan.

Any person aggrieved by the Plan may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that the document is not within the appropriate powers or that a procedural requirement has not been complied with. Any application must be made no later than six weeks after the date of adoption (14 May 2013).
